Dear Parents/Guardians,

[1] On Thursday, 21st May, to prepare for the Form 6 graduation ceremony, students will follow a special timetable, and school will be dismissed at 1:00 PM. Afternoon activities will be canceled.

[2] On Friday, 22nd May, the Form 6 graduation ceremony will be held. Form 1 to Form 4 students do not need to attend school.

[3] There is a Pre-Exam Revision period from 18th May to 1st June. S.1-5 students are required to stay in their classrooms after school from 19th May to 20th May and from 26th May to 29th May for pre-exam revision under the supervision of teachers until 5:00 pm. With the exception of certain sports team activities, all other extracurricular activities will be suspended.

[4] The final exams for Form 1 to Form 5 will be held from 2nd June to 12th June. Please urge your child to study diligently and strive for the best results. If a student does not give their best effort in the exam or shows a significant decline in the exam results, it will affect their academic ranking and promotion to the next class. The school will require the student to take a make-up exam on a specified date to fulfill their responsibility for diligent study. Parents are advised to take note.

[5] Students must pay attention to and comply with the rules for uniform tests and examinations as stated in the student handbook.

[6] There will be revision periods on each exam day. Students must bring books or notes to school to study.

[7] If the Education Bureau announces school closures due to weather or epidemic conditions, the exams scheduled for the day of closure will be cancelled. Exams will resume according to the timetable on the day of resumption, and the cancelled exams will be rescheduled.

[8] Students who are absent from the exam must call the school before 8:00a.m. to apply for leave. They must also submit a letter from their parents and a doctor's certificate on the day of their return to school. Failure to do so will be treated as intentional evasion of the exam and will result in disciplinary action.

[9] During the examination period, the daily assembly time is 8:00a.m. Students must arrive at school by 7:57a.m. (unless otherwise notified) and go home after completing the last subject of the day.

[10] Form 3 students must return to school for lessons on 15th and 16th June for post-exam review. (Details will be announced later.)

[11] Students are required to return to school on the mornings of 17th and 18th June to take the TSA written assessments. On 17th June, arrival is at 8:00am, and dismissal will be at 11:55am. On 18th June, arrival is at 8:00 am, with dismissal at approximately 12:30pm.

[12] Post-exam activities and make-up classes will be held from 17th June to 3rd July. (Details will be announced later.)

[13] The closing ceremony will be held on 6th July. All students who have successfully been promoted to the next grade will receive their report cards and complete student registration procedures (collect book lists and back-to-school information) on the day of the closing ceremony to confirm their place for the next academic year.

[14] If you have not yet paid the miscellaneous fees for the start of this academic year (Parent notice 25058) or the non-standard item charges (Parent notice 25126), please ensure that these fees are settled before completing the registration process. For any inquiries, please contact the class teacher.

[15] The examination venues for Form Three classes are as follows: 3A (Room 404), 3B (Room 405), 3C (Room 406).
